- Section 2391(d) of title 10, United States Code, authorizes the Sec Def to, "make grants, conclude cooperative agreements, and supplement funds available under Federal programs administered by agencies other than the Department of Defense, for
- projects owned by a State or local government, or a not-for-profit, member-owned utility service to address deficiencies in community infrastructure that support the local installation
- Off installation projects





• **Community infrastructure projects**: transportation, school, hospital, emergency response, or other community support facility; or water, telecom, electric, gas, or other utility infrastructure project, that:

□ support a military installation;

□ are owned by a state or local government

□ will enhance military family quality of life, resilience or military value at installation;

endorsed by the local installation commander which benefits from the propose project; and

 \Box are construction-ready.





- (Tier I) military family quality of life
- (Tier II) resiliency
- (Tier III) military value at a local installation





- 2020: \$50M for 14 Quality of Life projects only Tier 1
- Mostly Recreation/Community Center projects
- 2021: \$100M
- Projects expected to be in all three tiers
- CO endorsement
- Projects shovel ready
- Work needs to be started within 12 months
- NEPA requirements





- Tier I : Community Center
- Tier II : Crosswalk MD 235 Great Mills Rd/Gate 2
- Tier III: Glenn Forest neighborhood individual water metering and backflow prevention
- Other projects?
