IGSA Authority



- **Section 331 of the NDAA 13, 10 USC 2679**
 - *Grants installations the authority to enter into IGSAs with state and local governments to receive, provide, or share Installation Support Services*
- **ASN Memo (12 Apr '17) and CNIC Memo (2 May '17) delegated IGSA approval authority**
 - *CNIC - \$250K - \$1M/yr-Regions - less than \$250K/yr- Installations - less than \$100K/yr*
- **ASN Memo (01 Mar 19) delegated increase authority**
 - *CNIC –up to \$5M, Regions-\$2M, ICO - \$1M*



IGSA GOALS



- **Create efficiency by off-boarding non-mission critical tasks and functions**
- **Increase focus and efficiency to advance mission effectiveness in mission critical tasks and functions**
- **Maintain or improve services for Sailors, Marines and their families**
- **Strengthen relationships between installations and communities**

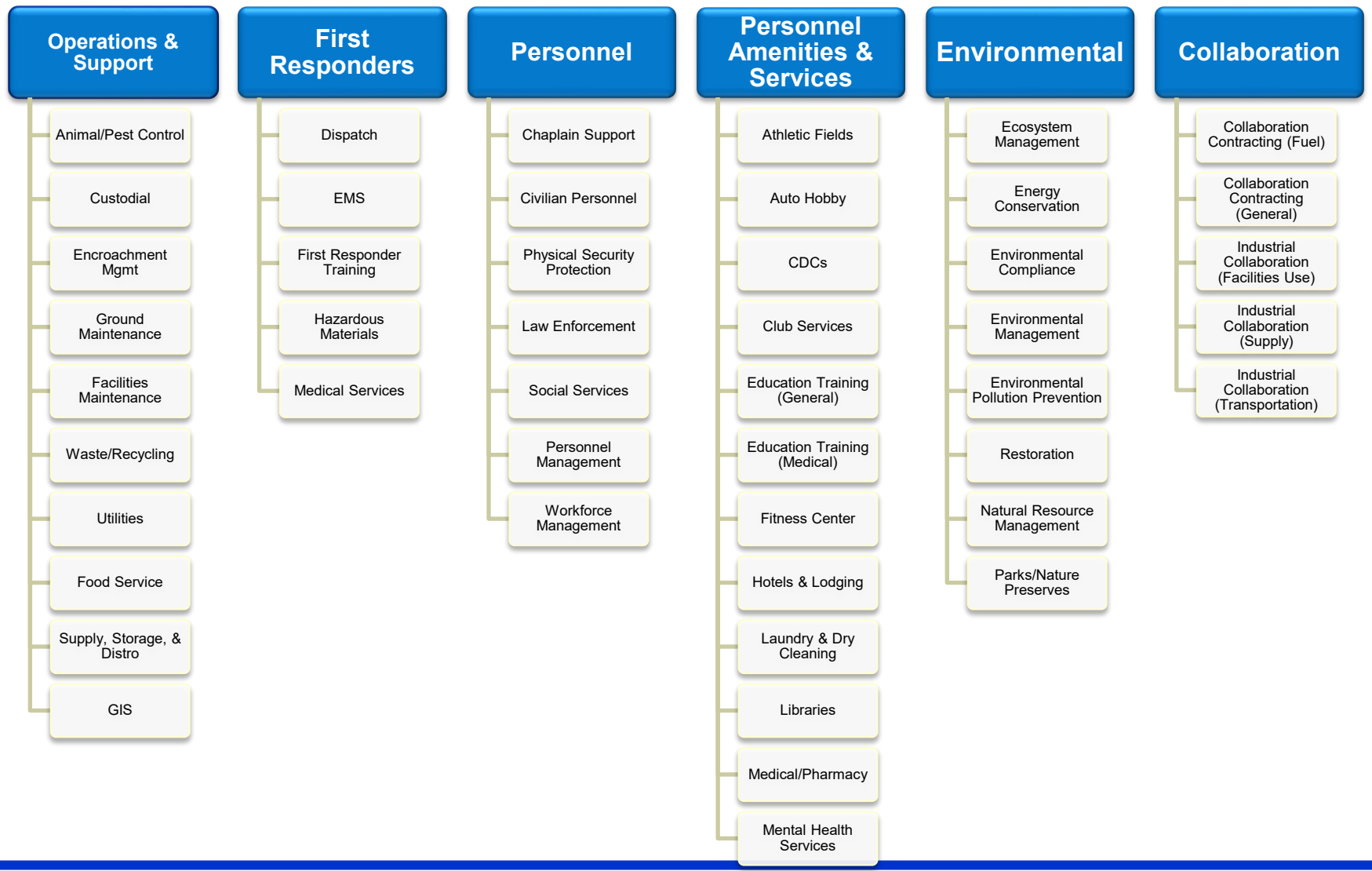
